



City Seeking Applications for Accessibility Advisory Board

The Stillwater City Commission recently established the Accessibility Advisory Board and is now soliciting applications from interested citizens wanting to be considered for appointment. The 9-member board will advise and make recommendations to the city manager and staff on matters related to accessibility. This would include reviewing city programs and services, evaluating projects and activities, and providing technical assistance to the city manager on matters related to the disabled.

Membership on the committee will include no less than four persons with a disability or persons with immediate family members with a disability, as defined by the Americans with Disabilities Act. The Community Relations Committee will designate one of their members to serve on the Accessibility Board. For the remaining positions, preference will be given to those who regularly work with disabled individuals, with expertise regarding accessibility issues, or representing the business, property development, medical or educational sectors.

The process to apply includes submitting an application accompanied by two recommendations. The application and recommendation forms are available at the Municipal Building, 723 South Lewis, and are also available on the city's web page Stillwater.org under Advisory Boards. The Mayor and City Commission will review all applications and make the formal appointments.
