Background / Issue:	On February 24, 2020, City Council approved the recommendation of the Recycling Task Force to pursue the possibility of constructing a recycling staging facility, which would include a convenience collection center.
Proposal/Solution:	<p>Staff has identified property owned by the City of Stillwater located adjacent to Whittenburg Park along Hwy 177. The location has the acreage for the construction of the recycling staging facility and a convenience collection center.</p> <p>At this point, staff is only seeking approval for the use of the property as a potential transfer station. No additional plans are made nor funds identified. As plans are developed and funding sources identified, the Trustees will be asked for action.</p>
Financial Impact/Funding Source(s):	The use of the land has no financial impact. Any future constructions plans will have funding sources identified.
