Background / Issue:	<p>For many years, The Mission of Hope has benefited from funding from the Housing and Urban Development (HUD) Agency for its day-to-day operation of the homeless shelter located in Stillwater. The \$50,000 Emergency Solutions Grant (ESG) will aid funding for residents in the following areas:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • emergency shelter, • administration, • Rapid re-housing, • outreach, and • prevention services.
Proposal/Solution:	The City of Stillwater must grant approval for the Mission of Hope to apply for this grant. By authorizing this grant application, a critical population will continue to receive the valuable services needed.
Financial Impact/Funding Source(s):	This project will not impact the City of Stillwater budget.
