Background / Issue:	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • June 3, 2019, a parking space lease agreement with Francis Solar was approved for the installation of public electric vehicle (EV) charging stations. • September 16, 2019, the General Service (GS) Rate was updated to allow for the resale of electricity by public EV charging station owners. • GS rate included language that stated EV charging stations utility service would be provided until a new EV charging station rate was implemented.
Proposal/Solution:	<p>Working with Avant Energy, staff has created an EV charging rate tariff for public chargers. The new rate is designed to recover the full cost to serve these customers and, if approved via Resolution SUA-2020-3, will begin July 1, 2020.</p> <p>Attached to this report is the EV rate letter, which summarizes in detail the background, analysis, proposed rate, and effect of rate change on the SUA's single existing customer.</p>
Financial Impact/Funding Source(s):	Adoption of Resolution SUA-2020-3 will enable the full recovery of the cost to provide EV charging stations to customers.
