

Fire Fighter Written Examination
EOC Technology Center/Stillwater Fire Department

Information and Instructions

1. Fire fighter written examinees shall not carry into the examination center or have in their possession cell phones, pagers, or other electronic devices during the examination.
2. Fire fighter written examinees shall not have in their possession at any time during the examination a calculator or any electronic spelling or grammar aides.
3. Fire fighter written examinees shall present their study guide in like new condition, and a photo ID to gain entrance to testing center. **FAILURE TO PRESENT THESE TWO ITEMS WILL RESULT IN THE EXAMINEE FAILING TO TAKE THE EXAMINATION. SHOULD THIS HAPPEN, THE \$30 TESTING FEE WILL BE FORFEITED.**
4. The examinees should report for the examination one hour prior to the posted beginning time for the test. The test will begin as soon after the posted beginning time for the test has arrived, all examinees are seated, and the test administrator is ready to begin. The fire fighter examination last for 2 hours and 30 minutes. Should an examinee have a doctor verified disability, he or she will be allowed 3 hours and 45 minutes to complete the examination. This must be declared when the examinee signs up for the test and it must be properly indicated on the enrollment form in the correct box. It is the responsibility of the examinee to provide written verification from a medical doctor of the impending condition that requires additional time for the examination. The examinee shall bring the written verification to the testing site and give it to the test administrator prior to the beginning of the test.
5. Fire fighter written examinees shall be notified by first class mail concerning the results of the examination within 10 business days of the examination. **NO RESULTS WILL BE GIVEN OVER THE TELEPHONE.**
6. Fire fighter written examinees shall bring with them 4 #2 pencils to be used during the examination.
